Procedure, procedures and methodologies anti-doping controls. Obligations of athletes and coaches during the procedure anti-doping controls. Notification procedures for therapeutic use exemptions (TUE). Procedures in cases belonging to the registered control group and the obligation to report locations of training and preparation. Planning training, nutrition and supplementation as an effective alternative to the use of doping in sport unprofessional.
