7. A half-**/marathon/** is a running race over a distance of about 21 kilometres.
8. In **/hammer/-**throwing a heavy metal ball joined to a cable is thrown as far as possible.
9. In **/high/** jump competitors try to jump over a bar supported on two poles.
10. The **/inside/** lane is also the part of a racetrack nearest the middle.
11. A **/jogging/** suit consists of a shirt and loose trousers which are worn when going running.

12. A **/lap/** of honour (US: victory lap) is a run/walk around a track made by a winner.
13. If you run a **/middle/-**distance race, you run 800 or 1500 metres.
14. The **/outside/** lane is the part of a racetrack that is furthest from the centre.
15. In **/physical/** education children at school do exercise and learn to play sport.
16. In **/pole/** vault you jump over a high bar using a long stick.
17. In shot **/put/** you throw a metal ball as far as possible.
18. In a **/relay/** race there are two or more team members. Each person in the team runs part of the race.
19. A run-**/up/** is a period or distance of running to be going fast enough to perform well.
20. In **/triple/** jump the athlete jumps three times to jump as far as possible.
