The TALENT project, funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, is setting a new standard for inclusive and holistic support of young athletes across Europe. Aimed at promoting equal access to education while fostering sporting excellence, TALENT supports the dual careers of talented youth aged 12 to 16 by bridging the gap between school and sports.

Through a cloud-based educational platform, TALENT empowers teachers, coaches, parents, and students with tools to identify, nurture, and support gifted young athletes. The project focuses on preventing school and sport dropouts by offering training modules, national and international best practices, and awareness-raising activities that build a more supportive environment for dual careers.

Led by a diverse consortium of educational institutions, universities, NGOs, and research centers across six European countries, TALENT combines scientific research with practical application. The project also places strong emphasis on inclusivity and innovation, ensuring that every talented child has the opportunity to thrive both academically and athletically.
