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Training Materials to Empower Coaches and Educators

TALENT Project Equips Professionals for Talent Recognition and Development

As part of the Erasmus+ Sport project *TALENT*, a set of comprehensive training materials has been developed to strengthen the capacity of teachers and sports coaches in identifying and supporting talented children. These materials are based on the project's evidence-informed approach and are designed to promote inclusive, supportive, and sustainable environments in both educational and sports contexts.

Structured Learning for Impact

The training programme is organised into four core modules, focusing on key areas such as talent identification, inclusive teaching and coaching practices, effective teamwork, and strategies for dual-career support. Each module integrates theoretical frameworks with practical case studies and hands-on exercises to ensure relevance, applicability, and immediate usability in the field.

Piloted Across Six Countries

The materials were piloted through a 30-hour training course held in all six partner countries—Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Greece, Serbia, and Bosnia and Herzegovina. More than 150 educators and coaches participated in these sessions. Feedback from participants emphasised the value of interactive methods, the importance of adapting content to local realities, and the need for continuous professional learning opportunities.

















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Sustainable Integration through E-STOP Platform

The training content will now be fully embedded into the TALENT E-STOP platform, where it will support ongoing capacity-building initiatives. By providing professionals with effective tools and up-to-date knowledge, the TALENT project aims to reinforce local support systems for young athletes and ensure lasting impact in dual-career development across Europe.

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
